## The Data Governance Act ("DGA"): Fostering trust in data sharing, improving data availability and overcoming technical obstacles related to the reuse of data in development of European data spaces

The <u>Data Governance Act</u> ("DGA") is a key pillar of the <u>European strategy for data</u>. The DGA seeks to increase trust in data sharing, strengthen mechanisms to increase data availability and overcome technical obstacles related to the reuse of data. The DGA furthermore supports the establishment and development of common European data spaces in strategic domains which involve both private and public players in sectors such as health, environment, energy, agriculture, mobility, finance, manufacturing, the public administration and data-related skills.

The Data Governance Act entered into force on 23 June 2022. Following a 15-month grace period, it will be applicable from September 2023. This session will focus on the re-use of certain categories of data held by public sector bodies, data intermediation services, data altruism, and the role of the European Data Innovation Board.
